

# Quick Installation Guide

## System Requirements

1. Available USB port
2. Microsoft® Windows® 2000, Windows® XP or Windows® Vista operating system
3. CD-ROM drive (for CD or Video operation)
4. Standard sound card (for CD or Video operation)
5. Microsoft® Office 97 or later version
6. Microsoft® Internet Explorer 5.0 or later version (for the Internet keys)

## Hardware Installation

Plug the mouse USB connector directly into the USB port on the PC.

## Driver Installation

### ◆ USB Device Driver

The USB device driver is included in your Windows operating system.

During the initial installation of the mouse USB device, the system will automatically detect that a new hardware device has been added, and will bring up the "Add New Hardware Wizard" dialogue box. Follow the Wizard's USB driver installation steps. Once this installation step is completed, the basic functions of the USB device will work under the operating system. Additional functions are provided only after the "HP Optical 4 Button USB Mouse" driver is installed.

### ◆ HP Optical 4 Button USB Mouse Driver

1. Insert the CD labeled " *HP Optical 4 Button USB Mouse* " into your CD-ROM.
2. The CD will run automatically and bring up the Setup dialogue box.
3. Then follow the on-screen instructions to install the driver.
4. The driver icon  will show at the bottom right corner in the Windows system tray when the driver is loaded.

## Usage Information

1. This optical mouse senses light to detect the mouse's movement; therefore, it cannot work on a glass, translucent, reflective, or dark color surface.
2. The mouse can work only on a clean, flat, non-slippery, opaque, and light color surface in order to ensure smooth and accurate cursor movement.
3. The PC will go into sleep mode after a period of inactivity or via other functions. It requires only one mouse click to resume the PC from sleep mode.
4. The maximum mouse resolution is 1000dpi (500 dpi with Interpolation to 1000dpi).
